- Make sure to talk with placement about which week and camp would work best.

- The child does not need to be enrolled in Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, or the YMCA to attend the summer camps.

Tucson Parks and Rec

The Parks and Rec offers summer activities like Kidco, sport classes, art classes, music sessions, and more.

Kidco summer camps provide full day activities for kids. Kidco fills up fast. Placement must register on May 4th.

Registration for summer 2024 will begin on Saturday, May 4, at 6 a.m. for city-residents and noon for non-city residents
Programming is available for ages 5-11 years old (must have completed kindergarten)

Programming is available in June and July, Monday-Friday from 7:30 a.m.-6 p.m. (except June 19 and July 4 for holidays). Locations vary

Registration sells out fast. Placement must register on May 4th right at 6am to ensure their child gets into Kidco.

Each week students complete 2 themes, one in the morning and one in the afternoon. Themes include instruction in drawing, painting, sculpting and more.
